## V. Speaker: Food and Nutrition Services - Ryan Mikolaycik

- All the snacks we provide at schools are free of high fructose corn syrup, artificial dyes, MSG, and trans fat. There are no nut ingredients at the elementary schools.
- A lot goes into the menu that is sold at the schools. We have two hot items and one classic item, a lot of what is served has to do with the costs of the items and what funding is available to our school.
- We have lots of new menu items: all juices we sell now are all natural juices. We now serve Cool water beverages, whole grain Cheetos, rainbow goldfish, burger patties, fresh bread from Kurz, and have switched all of syrups over to the natural brand.
- We now offer kids a birthday coupon each month instead of the birthday celebrations in the classroom.

- Spending update we were able to get the Math dry erase board for grade 3,4, and 5.
- We got approved for the Gaga pit shade and the shade structure for the outdoor picnic area.
- The district approved a new Marquee for the school and they are going to pay for it! They are going to run it into the budget for the new schools being built so we are hoping that we will get that sometime this summer. They are hoping the marquee will be digital if the community approves it.
