Principle Report – Sam Hicks

- Office team fully staffed now
 - o Susan Gadberry new admin assistant
 - o Rena El-Sadek new office assistant
- Staar has changed, now one test a week need parent volunteers to monitor hallways during this time
- Safety concerns and how they are being adressed:
 - o controlled access to the building must have badges or stickers
 - o bond money will improve access point in front office; bullet resistant glass, new entryway, maybe this summer
 - o clear plans for if something happens posters for drills; drill regularly for specific events (lockdown, active shooter, etc)
 - o No one has to wait to call 911 if you see something
 - o culture of safety- want to train the kids not to open the door for people in classrooms (at all school levels)
 - o cafeteria, front doors and kinder gate/doors are main access points
 - o will eventually be a buzzer to get into front doors
 - o educate kids on safety, bullying,
 - o cavs tip line: work on getting students familiar to how to use that, or write a note
 - o Rule he wishes he could change when you implement a consequence to a student, privacy policy is that he can't tell other parents what that is

- o when there is a threat to someone (self harm or to someone else): do a threat assessment and it automatically goes straight to Norton, Police dept, etc will take immediate action and everyone will know
- o Dial 911- goes straight to district, etc
- o partner with community; lakeway police response time is 2 minutes to LWE
- o Ltisd police not here as much right now, but looking for more in the future
- Pto pays for off duty cops at major events
- o Parents are a big part of keeping us all safe see something say something we are all part of the security
- o Parents asked to come up at recess and lunch for 4th/5th grade as extra eyes
- o Parents can meet one on one if you want to discuss this
- 36 literacy volunteers plus library volunteers everyone should keep an eye on things
- Changes to LWE in future:
 - No plan of anything different for zoning right now
 - No hiring until mid to late May
 - Always need monitors and TA's, PE teacher (Judson retired)
 - Some of old lakeway might come back to us at some point potentially
- New initiative: Mustang class/student of the week for positive reinforcement
